
BOB BOX SET SERIES: "CROSS"



INTRODUCTION

This play is part of a Box Set Series where you run different plays from the same box set. I recommend selecting 1 or 2 of these plays as your regular BOB (Baseline Out-Of-Bounds) actions and keeping the other(s) up your sleeve for a "Need" situation!


OVERVIEW

Offensive Set: Box Set

Key Action: Back-Screen & Comeback
Designed for: Post Player or Best Finisher
Against: Man, Zone & Switching Def.

PERSONNEL

- Best Passer / Decision Maker
- ② Best Shooter
- 3 Best Cutter / 2nd Best Shooter
- 4 Best Finisher
- Best Rebounder / 2nd Best Finisher



EXECUTION

- (1) 4 & 5 simultaneously cross screen for 2 & 3
 These screens are decoys (diagram 1)
- (2) 4 back-screens for 5 who will cut hard to the weak side block (1st option)
- (3) after the back-screen ④ will reverse pivot, seal and comeback to the ball (2nd & main option)

You will be surprised how frequently this play will work if you get your screener to set a good screen first and then comeback to the ball in a timely manner!

NOTE

Do not be afraid to shuffle players around according to their strengths. It is far more important to set up your best finisher then necessarily a big player. Your best passer must be the inbounder even if he or she is your best shooter!
