
BOB BOX SET SERIES: "BRUSH"



INTRODUCTION

This play is part of a Box Set Series where you run different plays from the same box set. I recommend selecting 1 or 2 of these plays as your regular BOB (Baseline Out-Of-Bounds) actions and keeping the other(s) up your sleeve for a "Need" situation!

OVERVIEW

Offensive Set: Box Set


Key Action: Brush/Double Screen

Designed for: Best Shooter

Against: Man & Zone Defense

PERSONNEL

- Best Passer / Decision Maker
- ② Best Shooter
- 3 Best Cutter / 2nd Best Shooter
- 4 Best Finisher
- ⑤ Best Rebounder / 2nd Best Finisher



EXECUTION

- (1) ③ will initiating the action by flash cutting to the front of the rim. Looking to score is imperative, however the purpose of this cut is to force congestion and confusion!
- (2) ② will cut in the wake of ③ using the double screen set by ④ & ⑤ (diagram 1)
- (3) Diagram 2 illustrates the same action vs the zone. It is important to note that 4 & 5 have to adjust their screening and screen the top and the bottom player of the zone. Depending on their alignment 2 may have to go between 4 & 5!

NOTE

Do not be afraid to shuffle players around according to their strengths. It is far more important to set up your best finisher then a big player. Your best passer must be the inbounder even if he or she is your best shooter!
