

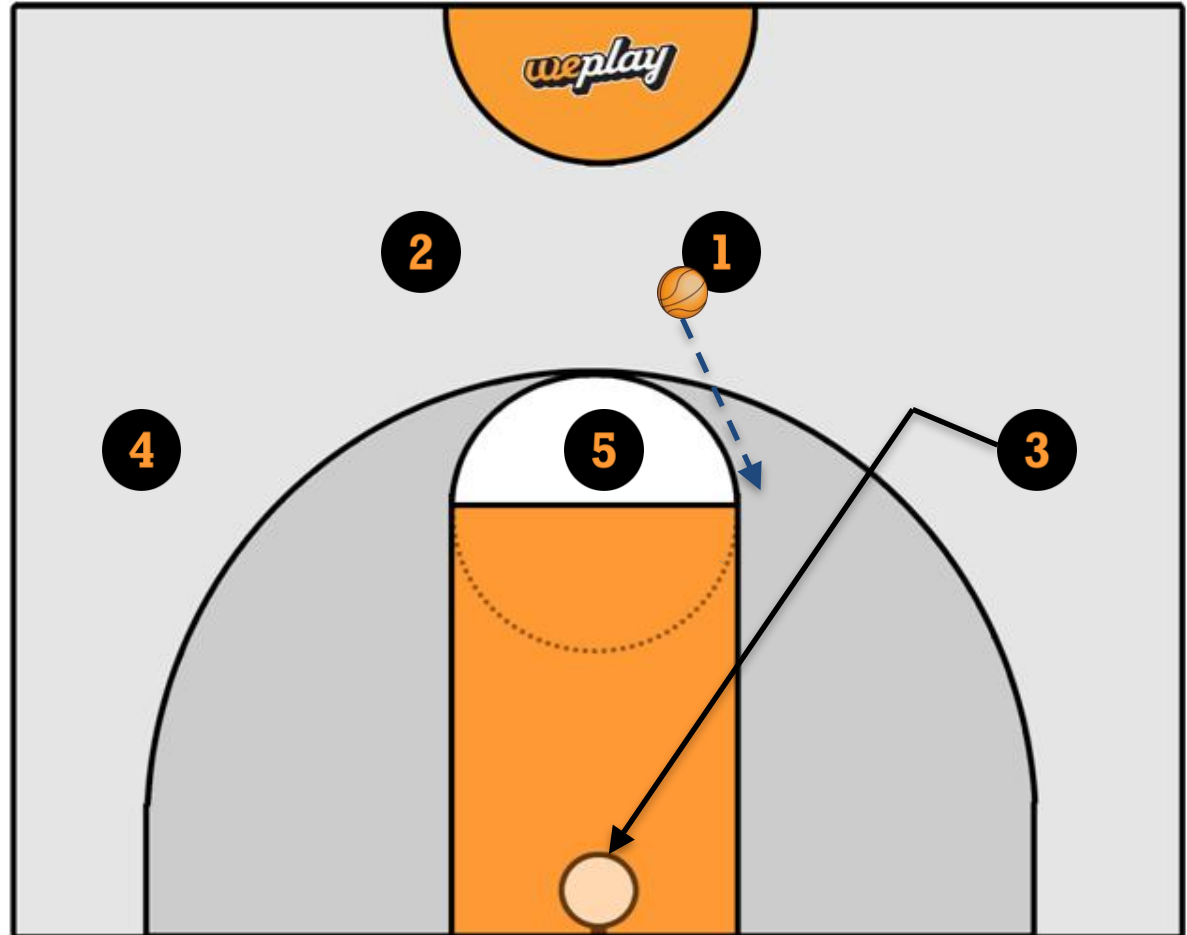
DESCRIPTION

By spacing all players above the free throw line, this play is ideal for a backdoor cut that will finish in a wide open layup.

1. The (1) initiates the play by faking a pass to the (3) who attempts to meet the pass but then cuts diagonally towards the hoop.

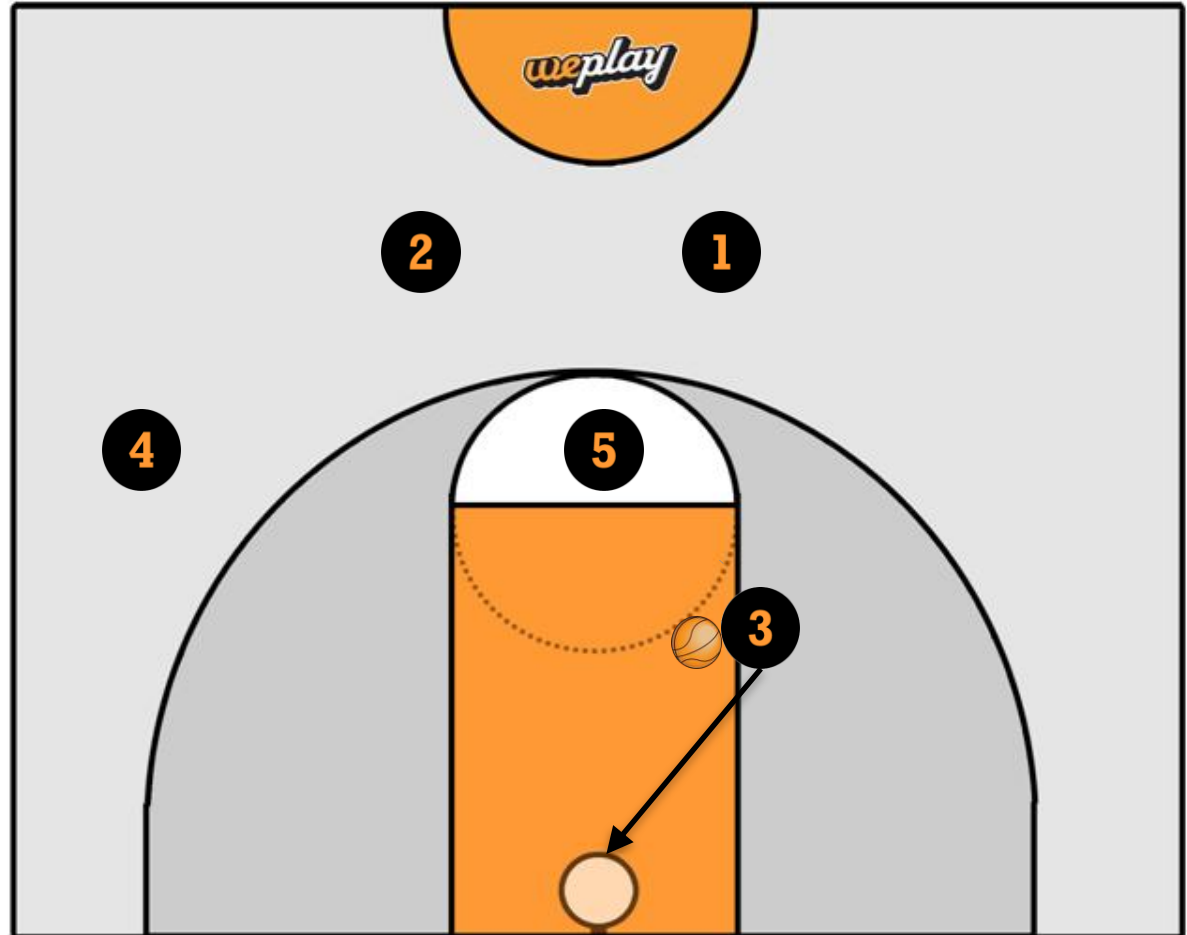
