

DESCRIPTION

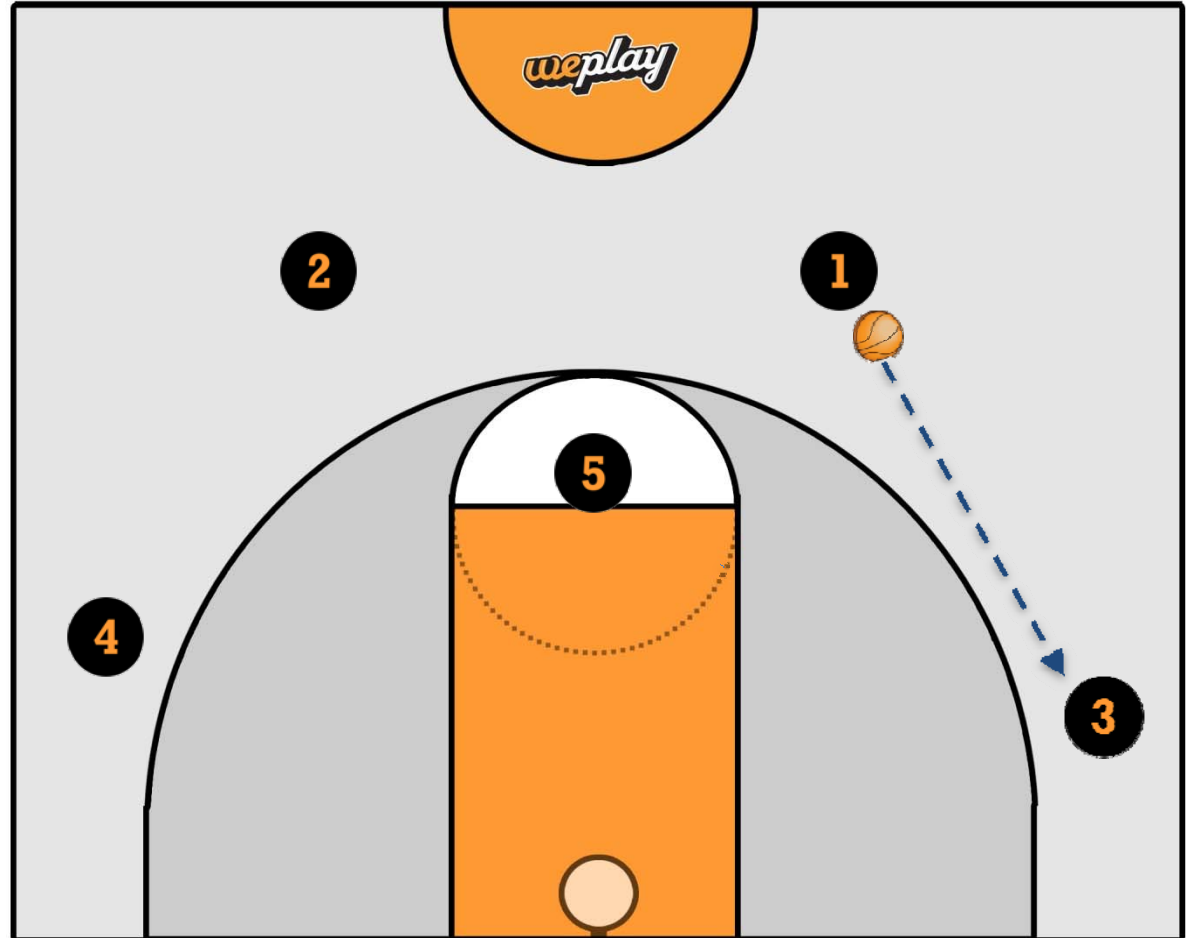
The x-cross play aims for a wide open layup to develop, whether it is through the initial x-cross or off the subsequent ball reversal.

1. The (1) passes to the (3) and leads the (1) and (2) to x-cross above the (5) to go to the blocks, while the (4) heads to the top of the key.
2. The (3) then has the option to pass to the (2) if open for a layup, or else reverse the ball to the (4) as the (1) pops out to the wing.
3. The (4) passes to the (1) who will be waiting for the (3) to use a screen by the (2) to pass him/her the ball for the open layup at the other block.
