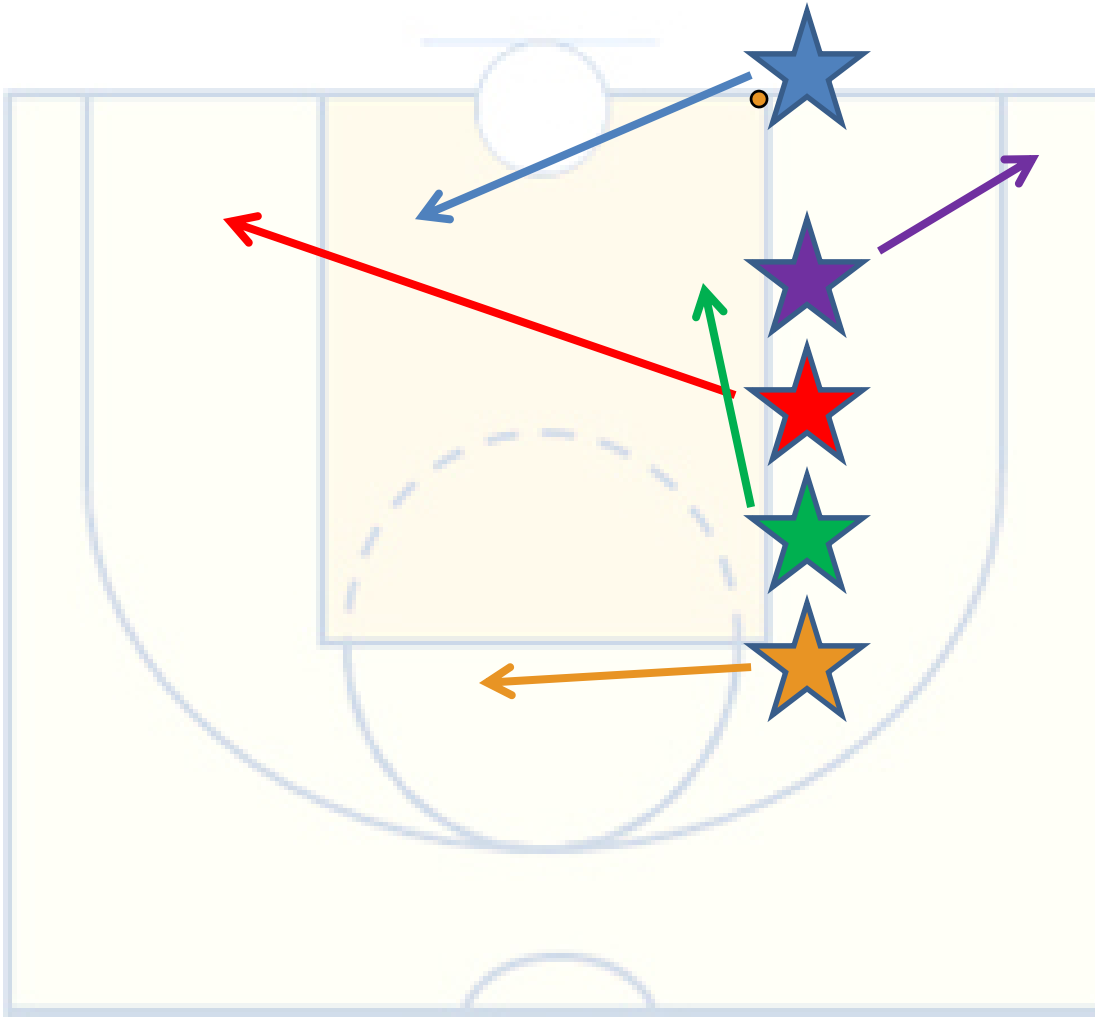


The “Stack” Out-of-Bounds Play

An out-of-bounds play for inbounding underneath the offensive basket.



Execution:

- The first two players (purple) and (red) split right and left. They can go in either direction and switch it up next time.
- The third player (green) slips into the empty space left by the first two and might be ready for an open lay-up.
- The fourth player (orange) slides to the left as a safety outlet.
- If the pass goes to the orange, then inbounding player (blue) cut to the low post area for a pass back.
